- Students could not attend their classes due to lack of internet facilities, availability of single phone, many health issues like covid-19, pregnancy, delivery and houseold work.
- 90% students found their classes' interesting and 83% students responded that they were provided study material by their teachers.
- 96% students agreed that teachers were helpful and 94% students approached their teachers for guidance and support.
- Majority of students responded that college infrastructure was food. 70% students were satisfied with college administrative support and 80% students were satisfied with the library staff.
